- `script <session1>`

- To stop recording: `exit`

- To clean your script from color and control characters use:

```
col -bp < session1 > session1.txt
```

- And of course convert line endings for the operating system you are using: `unix2dos` – to read on windows

- `<program_name> --help`
- `info coreutils '<program_name> invocation'`

- ls (-l, -R, -F, -i, -a)
- pwd
- cp

- rm (-r, -f)
- Compress: bzip2, tar
- wget <url>

- cat
- less
- head (-n)
- tail (-n)
- sort (-n, -r, -k)
- uniq
- wc (-l, -w, -c, -m)
- comm
- diff
- grep (-i, -w, -c, -r, -v, patterns: * and ^)
- file and (dos2unix, unix2dos)
